CONDITIONS

2. The approval scope shall not exceed the permitted UK Part-145 ratings as detailed UK Reg (EU) No. 1321/2014.
3. This approval requires continued compliance with 14 CFR part 145 and the differences as specified in the Maintenance Agreement Guidance (MAG), including the use of the FAA Form 8130-3 for release/return to service of components up to and including power plants.
4. For components, certificates for release/return to service must quote the UK Part-145 approval reference number quoted above and the 14 CFR part 145 Air Agency Certificate number.
5. For aircraft, certificates for release to service must quote the UK Part-145 approval reference number quoted above.
6. Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, this approval shall remain valid until:
09 DECEMBER 2026
unless the approval is surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
